For event #2 we have 3 of the new Remington Sportsman 11-87, 3" shot guns. One for the winner of each yardage group.

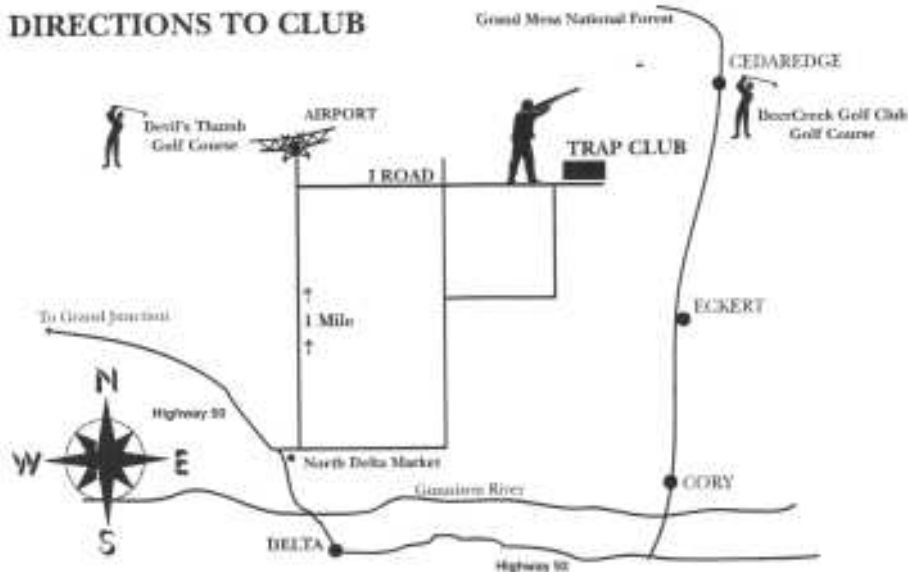

GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration desk opens at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 3, 2010, and at 7:00 a.m. each day following. **HAVE YOUR ATA SCORES PROPERLY RECORDED PRIOR TO THIS SHOOT TO SAVE TIME.**

Classification will be based upon accepted ATA procedures. Any Shooter who has registered less than 500 16-yard, 1000 Handicap, and 300 Doubles for the 2010 target year and previous (2) two years aggregate will be required to shoot penalty yardage and classification. Each day's targets will apply to minimum target requirements. Penalty classification and yardage will be:

Men	B	22	B
Ladies & Sub-Juniors	C	20	C
Juniors	B	22	B

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to reclassify any shooter at any time during the shoot. The ATA Rules will govern all points that are not otherwise provided. If you earn yardage in any Handicap event, it is your RESPONSIBILITY to report such change to the Committee.

We will follow the ATA Rules regarding special category shooters for shoots where there is All American points involved.

There will be no squad changes unless requested by Delta Trap Club.

NOTICE TO CLUBS: Bring a full team if possible for Event # 2. You do not have to be on a team to shoot for purse, options or trophies.

The shoot will be shot over 12 traps using 3 banks shooting 25 targets per trap except doubles. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules.

No purse or option money may be entered or withdrawn after squad # 1 completes its first sub-event.

New shells will be available at the club. Reloads permitted if ATA rules are complied with.

NO OUTSIDE SALE OF SHELLS OR COMPONENTS ON PREMISES!

ATA Fees - \$2.00 per day CSTA Fees - \$4.00 per day

Orange dome White Flyer targets will be thrown.

All money will be paid by check and will be mailed promptly following the shoot.

Trophies will not be mailed.

Shoot-offs will be held after each day's last registered event unless agreed otherwise.

Practice traps will be open Friday afternoon, September 3, 2010, and at 7:00 a.m. each day, and prior to start of each event.

Practice tickets - \$5.00.



To avoid short squads, shooters must be registered and paid before the first registered event or the remaining squad will be opened up to the public **FOR ALL REMAINING EVENTS.**

Delta Trap Club reserves the right to modify the shoot program or the number of entries. This printed program will absolutely govern the Tournament. The Amateur Trapshooting Association Rules will govern all points not otherwise provided for. The Management reserves the absolute right in its sound discretion, at any time prior to or during this Tournament to change or modify this program in any manner it desires.

DISQUALIFICATION: The management reserves the right to refuse any entry or disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.

CALCUTTA DISCLAIMER: The Delta Trap Club will not be financially responsible if you buy a shooter and that shooter is a no-show, is disqualified, or withdraws. The only exception will be in case of an emergency where the club management determines that the shooter should be allowed to withdraw and receive refunds. In that case, the buyer will be refunded 50% of the purchase price of the pair. **At the start of the Auction the "FLOOR" will be sold for ALL shooters receiving no bid.**

ATA RULES PROHIBIT THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL PRIOR TO OR DURING PARTICIPATION IN ANY EVENT OR PRACTICE AT ANY REGISTERED TOURNAMENT. PLEASE KEEP THIS A SAFE SHOOT.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCORE AFTER FIRING AT EACH 5 TARGETS. According to ATA rules, the score keeper must keep the score sheet in plain view of the shooters at all times. If the shooters insist on this, many arguments will be avoided. The squad captain (No. 1 shooter) will total the score after each 25 target event and initial the score sheet before leaving the trap. Errors made in totaling may and shall be corrected whenever discovered. No change in lost or broken targets will be made after the sheet leaves the scorekeeper. All scores posted for 1 hour will be considered final for the purpose of money pay out. After 1 hour any corrected scores will be reported to ATA. The above is the shooters responsibility per ATA Rule VII A-13.

Limited electrical RV hook-ups available. All units must be fully self-contained. Reservation fee of \$40.00 (\$50.00 for 50 Amp) is required to reserve a site. First come basis, mail reservation early. \$12. for every additional day. Free camper dump in town.

GUESTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR PETS SHORT LEASHED AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. IT IS ALSO MANDATORY THAT YOU CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET. NO PETS ARE PERMITTED IN THE CLUB HOUSE. YOU MUST ACCEPT FULL LIABILITY FOR YOUR PETS.

Pre-squadding will be used and available on the Website at www.presquad.com beginning July 1, 2010 and ending September 1, 2010. The cost is \$5.00 per shooter. Log on and have your ATA card and credit card ready for payment and other information asked for. As you log on, you will note other instructions to follow. Anyone not registered by www.presquad.com by September 1, 2010 will be squadded at time of arrival for the shoot. **NO OTHER FORMS OF PRE-SQUADDING WILL BE USED FOR THIS SHOOT.** You must shoot the same squad for events 5 & 6.

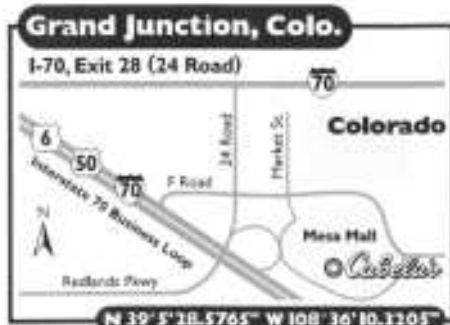

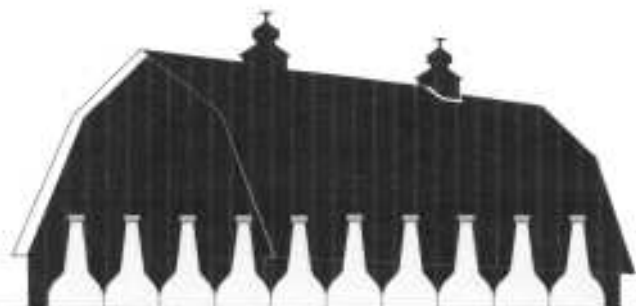

OFFICIAL RULES

Individual must participate in and complete the Saturday Handicap Event.

Upon completion of the event, the Delta Trap Club will publicly and randomly draw one number from zero to nine. The drawing will be held in the Delta Trap Club club house. Unduly delayed make-ups will be disqualified from participating in the promotion for that event. **Be sure to check your score promptly. For purpose of this promotion no scores will be changed after the random number is drawn.**

Shooters with a score ending in the number drawn will be eligible to shoot off. For example, if the number two (2) is drawn, all participants with a score of 92, 82, 72, 62 etc., are eligible to compete in the shoot-off.

A time and place for all qualifying shooters to be present for the Remington Shot Gun Shoot-Off will be announced over the PA system and posted on the score board.

At the appropriate time and place, all eligible shooters will assemble at the proper trap for a shoot-off by yardage group.

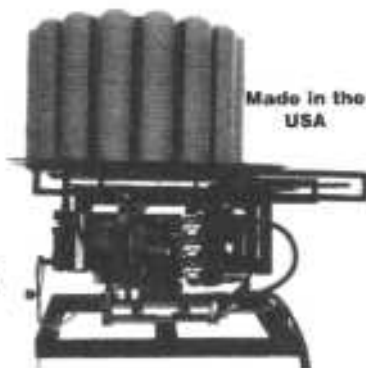

INGREDIENTS

4 Foster Farms Half Breasts

- 1 cup extra virgin olive oil
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 1/2 tablespoon honey
- 1/2 teaspoon saffron
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 teaspoon dried basil
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/4 teaspoon dried parsley
- 1 pinch dried sage

DIRECTIONS

1. Place chicken in a shallow dish. In a medium bowl, mix together the olive oil, sugar, honey, saffron, garlic, basil, thyme, cayenne pepper, salt, oregano, parsley, and sage. Pour the mixture over the chicken. Cover, and marinate 20 to 25 minutes in the refrigerator.
2. Preheat the grill for medium heat.
3. Lightly oil the grill grate. Discard marinade, and place chicken on the grill. Cook for 10 minutes on each side, or until exterior is charred and juices run clear.
